

# CROWDER COLLEGE BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP

## AWARD & RESPONSIBILITIES



### **2023 High School Senior Business Scholarship:**

- Based on need and merit. Professional and detailed essay responses are expected.
- \$500 per semester
- Renewable for up to 3 consecutive semesters (fall/spring only) for a maximum award amount of \$2,000.00
- Will be awarded at the beginning of the Fall 2023 semester after requirements have been met and verified by the Business Division Chair
- Number of awards: 1-3
- The online application should be completed by April 15<sup>th</sup> for first priority
- Award will be announced by May 1<sup>st</sup>

#### **Requirements:**

- Must be a high school senior
- Must attend Crowder College during the Fall 2023 semester
- Must major in a business degree at Crowder College (A.A. Business Administration or A.A.S. Business – Accounting or Management) and declare this major prior to the Fall 2023 semester
- Must be a full-time student (minimum 12 hours per semester)
- Must enroll in at least one business class each semester (ACCT, BMGT, BSAD, ECON)
- Must have and maintain at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale

#### **Renewal Requirements:**

- Must remain a business major
- Must be a full-time student (minimum 12 hours per semester)
- Must enroll in at least one business class each semester
- Must maintain at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale

#### **Application:**

- You may apply for multiple scholarships, but to apply for this scholarship, you must be a business major. Complete the online Crowder College Scholarship Application:
