2023 College Scholarships

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to receive one of New-Mac Electric Cooperative's college scholarships, a student must:

1. Be a senior attending one of the following high schools:

Carthage Neosho
Diamond Pierce City
East Newton Sarcoxie
Joplin Seneca
McDonald County Wheaton

- 2. Applicant's parent(s)/guardian(s) must be member(s) of New-Mac Electric Cooperative
- 3. Have a cumulative minimum 3.0 GPA
- 4. Immediate family members of New-Mac Electric employees/board members are ineligible

Guidelines

- 1. A total of 10 scholarships will be awarded. Each scholarship will be in the amount of \$500 and will be non-renewable. One scholarship will be awarded to a qualifying student in each of the 10 schools listed above.
- 2. The scholarship must be used at an accredited college or university. The scholarship funds will be issued directly to the college or university attended by the student.
- 3. The winner must become a full-time college student, beginning in the fall of 2023.
- 4. The winners will be asked to provide a student identification number when the scholarship is sent to the college of their choice.
- 5. Items for consideration will be: academic performance, school and community involvement, and financial need.

Instructions for Scholarship Application

- 1. A copy of your current high school transcript must be attached to your completed application.
- 2. If available, a copy of a letter of acceptance from the college you plan to attend, should be submitted.
